Important to know before exporting a PDF with our profiles:

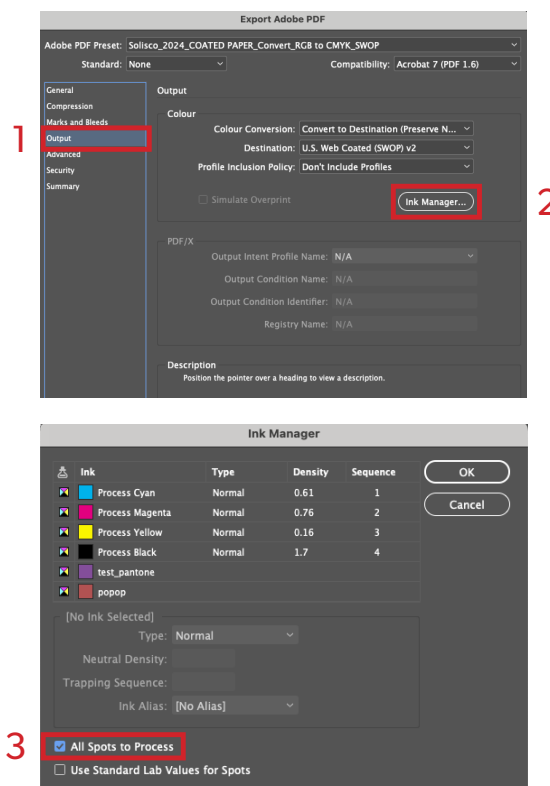
- You have to choose the **profile** based on the type of printer paper. There will be two types of profiles for the downloaded file: one for coated paper and one for uncoated paper.
- If there are still **RGB images** in the document, they will be converted during exportation of the PDFs when using the conversion profile that goes with the paper type.
- We strongly recommend **converting Pantone colours to CMYK** using InDesign's Ink Manager to avoid transparency issues that might arise later in the approval process.

How to export PDFs

You must provide your PDFs as single pages. (Cannot be a spread)



For perfect bound covers (glued), please provide the spine in a single document.

Contact your project manager to make sure you have the correct spine thickness.

File naming convention

For covers, please follow the examples below:

Shortened project name_issue #_C1.pdf

Shortened project name_issue #_C2.pdf

Shortened project name_issue #_C3.pdf

Shortened project name_issue #_C4.pdf

Example: Solisco_19_C1.pdf

For perfect binding projects (glued),
provide the spine in a separate document:

Shortened project name_issue #_Spine.pdf

Example: Solisco_19_Spine.pdf

For naming internal PDF pages:

Shortened project name_issue #_P01.pdf

Shortened project name_issue #_P10.pdf

Shortened project name_issue #_P100.pdf

Example: Solisco_19_P01.pdf

For a page in the first correction cycle:

Shortened project name_issue #_P01C.pdf

Example: Solisco_19_P01C.pdf

For a page in the second correction cycle:

Shortened project name_issue #_P01CC.pdf

Example: Solisco_19_P01CC.pdf

For files with several versions:

Version_Shortened project name_issue #_P100.pdf

EN_Solisco_19_P01.pdf

FR_Solisco_19_P01.pdf

Example: Solisco_19_P01.pdf

***Very important: The page number in the PDF file name must match the document's actual page number.**
